Item Removal List for Heat Treatment

In all cases it is ideal to leave as much inside the property as possible so it can be treated. The few exceptions are listed below:

Must Be Removed:

- Fire extinguishers, firearms, bullets, fireworks, lighters and solvents
- All pressurized aerosol cans such as, but not limited to: hair spray, insecticides, cooking sprays and paint cans
- Sprinkler heads removed and plugged (where applicable)
- Pets and live plants. Bathe pets and rinse off plants before returning.

Should Be Removed:

- Wax items including candles or music records
- DVD's and VHS cassettes
- Medicines/vitamins
- Batteries
- Fresh foods
- Food items that may melt such as chocolates
- Cosmetics that may soften in heat
- Oil paintings
- Arts and craft supplies (paint, crayons, etc)

Please remove all of the items listed and have them laundered or treated prior to treatment, placed in new plastic bags and sealed. Remove *immediately* from structure. Do not bring back inside until treatment is complete. **Please note: The removal of "Should" items is up to you.** If any item is removed there is a possibility bed bugs may be on it and could re-infest the property after treatment so inspect carefully.
